You will be creating a social media post for Instagram using Canva. A familiarity with basic Canva techniques is required (Templates, Elements, Text, Photos). You will be designing an Instagram Story with your daily class schedules. The class schedule will include days, times, and classes for your daily schedule. You may need to modify a template according to how many classes you have per day, however, have fun and be creative!

Directions:

- 1. Using **Templates**, search for social media **Instagram Stories**.
- 2. Click on **Create a Blank Instagram Story**.
- 3. Rename the file: Class Schedule.
- 4. Using **Templates**, search for **Class Schedule** or **School Schedule**.
- 5. Apply a template to your canvas.
- Customize text areas, elements, and/or photos to create a graphic with your weekly schedule. Include days, times, and classes.
- 7. When complete, select **Share** and **Download**. Choose File Type **PNG** and **Download**, **Insert into Graphics Portfolio**
