Management Functions

 At the most fundamental level, management is a discipline that consists of a set of five general functions: planning, organizing, staffing, leading and controlling. These five functions are part of a body of practices and theories on how to be a successful manager.

Your Task



 Imagine you are the manager of a retail store. Write a detailed script of your interactions with coworkers demonstrating the effective use of each management function.

Project Requirements

Your script must:

- Provide 3 examples for each management function and highlight each example you provide using the following color code:
 - Planning examples are yellow
 - Organizing examples are green
 - Staffing examples are turquoise (light blue)
 - Leading/Directing examples are fuchsia (purple)
 - Controlling examples are grey
- Be formatted as a script
 - Maintain a professional tone throughout
 - Contain no errors in spelling, grammar, or mechanics



Basic Script Formatting



- Use 1 inch margins
- Use 12 pt. Courier font
- Write in italics to describe the setting or actions
- Use names followed by a colon to indicate the speaker
- Skip a line between each speaker and scene
- Script must be a minimum of 2 pages in length

Step-by-Step Instructions

- Brainstorm real-life examples of each management function that could occur in a business environment.
- 2. Create your characters.
- 3. Open a word processing program and follow formatting instructions.
- 4. Write a script utilizing the examples you brainstormed.
- 5. Highlight each example as you go.
