### TRAVEL BROCHURE PROJECT

#### **Overview**

You will design a travel brochure using Canva. You must pick a destination prior to starting your design. It can be anywhere in the world, but you will have to calculate trip cost, so keep that in mind when making your choice.

### Requirements

You will use Canva to create your travel brochure. Your invitation should be  $11 \times 8.5$  inches. Use one of Canva's templates to create your brochure. Be sure to choose the brochure that is paper size.

- **5 Fun Facts** After choosing a destination, you will research it. You will need to list 5 fun facts about your destination. This information cannot be used elsewhere on your brochure, so be sure to plan for this.
- **Things To Do-** Research things to do at your destination. It's not a fun trip if you don't have anything planned!
- **Food** What types of cuisine are served in this region? What might you eat while at your destination?
- **Climate** Research the type of weather one can expect when traveling to this destination. You should also include information about what someone traveling to this region should pack.
- Graphics Your brochure should have two images at minimum. One
  of these images should be a map of the destination, with a star
  marking the place.
- **Travel Cost** A major part of travel is cost. You will calculate the rough cost of the trip. How will you get there? If flying, how much would a flight typically cost to this destination? How much are hotels per night at this destination? You should include this information on your brochure.

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- Professionalism You will be graded on the professionalism of your design. If it looks rushed and unfinished, you will not receive full points in this category. Use fonts that compliment one another, background colors, font colors, etc.
- **Grammar and Spelling -** Be sure you use proper grammar and spell-check your invitation before turning it in.
- **Sources** You should have a section on your brochure (or turn in a separate document) that lists all of the sources you used from your research. Include links to this information.
- Use of Canva Demonstrate your knowledge of Canva by using multiple elements from the left sidebar. Your invitation should showcase your expertise on Canva by creating an invitation that is beyond what you could create on Word or Google Docs.
