### HEADLINES

Space Shuttle Atlantis lands on July 21, 2011 at Kennedy Space Center in Florida, ending its 13-day mission. Atlantis safely touched down, bringing an end to the 30-year Space Shuttle program.

NEW YORK ----- The urban Northeast baked on Friday as record-breaking 100-degree temperatures and steam-bath humidity combined with the heat-trapping effects of asphalt and concrete to make millions of people miserable.

The mercury in Newark, N.J., reached 108, the highest temperature recorded in the city. New York City hit 104 degrees, 2 degrees short of its all-time high, and with the oppressive humidity, it felt like 113.
